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School-Age Program (B.A./BSW-level)

Casa Central's School-Age program provides afterschool programming designed to support children's development and wellbeing. Programming focuses on the academic, social emotional, physical health and recreational needs of children, and also includes a parent engagement component.

Population served: Children ages 5-12 (and their parents)

Internship learning opportunities: Assist in conducting family assessments and providing case management support, including information and referral and linkage; participate in program evaluation and performance and quality improvement activities; develop and deliver parent workshops; support the implementation of social emotional learning activities and other classroom-based activities; build relationships with children 1-1 and in small groups; provide homework help and support; support recruitment and marketing activities for the program.

Internship hours/scheduling available: Children are on-site Monday-Friday, 2pm-6pm; 2 semester placement

Group supervision with an LCSW is provided; students are required to have afternoon available either Tuesday or Wednesday between 4:30-6:30pm for participation in this group (exact time TBD)

Requirements:

Must comply with agency background checks, as well as drug and TB testing. Bilingual (English and Spanish) preferred but not required.
