Home Care Services (B.A./BSW-level)

Since 1982, the Home Care Services program has provided older adults and their families with crucial daily living assistance, supervision, and the socio-emotional support they need and deserve to remain safe, healthy, and independent within their own homes. Services include assistance with bathing, personal grooming, dressing, light housekeeping and laundry, grocery shopping and errands, medication reminders, scheduling/escorting participants to appointments, meal preparation and feeding assistance, as well as companionship.

Population served: Older adults, age 60 and older

Internship learning opportunities: Conduct home assessments, provide individual case management support, as well as information and referral to other community services; design and coordinate special program activities or projects; participate in program evaluation and performance and quality improvement activities; assist with older adult marketing activities and other initiatives, including networking with community partners; accompany home care supervisors on home visits; assist with pre-service training of home care aides.

Internship hours/scheduling available: Monday-Friday 9am to 5pm; 2 semester placement Group supervision with an LCSW is provided; students are required to have afternoon available either Tuesday or Wednesday between 4:30-6:30pm for participation in this group (exact time TBD)

Must comply with agency background checks, as well as drug and TB testing. Must be bilingual; English and Spanish Reliable transportation
