KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

If you are detained, you have the right to remain silent and contact a lawyer.

You have the right to a legal process and have your case presented before an immigration judge.

IF ICE CONTACTS YOU

If ICE visits your home or work, do not open the door until they present a court order.

Do not volunteer ANY information.

You do not need to provide your immigration status or place of birth.

Do not present false documentation or information, including a fake name.

You are not required to sign documents in English, Spanish, or other language without an attorney present.

Do you know a U.S. citizen, veteran or military service member, or permanent resident who is in ICE custody, or is being repatriated? Do you have immigration questions?
